- Model Programs
 - Rutgers

- Lack of Resources
 - E.g., 2 year waiting list for general anesthesia
 - Months to wait for other care
- Interest in dental community
 - Low pay rates
 - Lack of training
 - Lack of comfort

Caregivers and Self Advocates

Direct Service Providers training

- High turnover, lack of consistency
- Competing tasks

- Prioritization, Limits on Time

- Variation in Behaviors/Communication Ability
